- Wednesday Hebrew helper Help every Wednesday during Hebrew classes for 3rd-6th graders. Assist with instruction and classroom projects, and even lead the lesson on occasions.
- Special projects helper Help the director to plan special events for our Lifelong Learning community –
 including: A Day of Service in January and Passover University in April along with other special programs
 throughout the year

The role of an Ozer/et depends on the person. The Ozrim receive training in how to be an Ozer/et (how to lead the class, discipline management, writing lessons and programs...every aspect of leading and supporting learning).
