
The Jewish Federation of Greater Dallas is now accepting applications for need-based scholarships for teens who are attending summer programs in Israel.

In order to qualify for the scholarships, applicants must:

- 1. Live in Dallas
- 2. Demonstrate financial need
- 3. Be a current high school student and have the same status at the time of the Israel program.
- 4. Plan to participate in a recognized Israel experience program that is longer than 10 days and has educational content.

Students applying to attend summer programs in Israel must submit their completed application no later than March 15, 2021. More details can be found on the <u>website</u>
