How to Talk to Kids About What's Happening in Israel Right Now

Here are organizations that are recommended:

- 1. Friends of Israel Defense Forces (<u>www.FIDF.org</u>). This is an organization that is non-political and non-military organization that provides for wellbeing of the soldiers of the Israel Defense Forces, veterans and family members. Established in 1981 by a group of Holocaust survivors, FIDF is a 501c3 not-for-profit corporation that operates 26 regional offices in the United States with headquarters in New York City.
- 2. American Friends of Magen David Adom (<u>www.afmda.org</u>), is Israel's national emergency medical, disaster, ambulance and blood bank service to everyone in Israel.
- 3. The American Jewish Committee (<u>www.ajc.org</u>), is the global advocacy organization for the Jewish people.

As always we are here, in sacred partnership with you, to support your family and children as you apply the teachings of our tradition to navigate this complex world.
