There was so much activity and focus on joy, wonder, friendship and our holy community on Sunday.

In Hebrew Through Movement everyone learned the Hebrew names for Chanukah items and colors, too!

There was lots of dreidel fun! In Pre-K they made Chanukah cards with dreidels and in K-1st grade they made edible dreidels and played dreidel.

In 2nd grade they focused on the story of Abraham and they were GREAT teachers of Hebrew!

In 3rd-6th grade they spent time with Rabbi P learning about angels in Jewish tradition. They studied the text Genesis chapter 28 about Jacob's encounter with the angels. Be sure to ask your children about angels and the conversation they had with Rabbi P about how to treat angels or those who MIGHT be angels.

After spending time thinking about verse 28:15 (Jacob awoke from his sleep and said, "Surely יהוה is present in this place, and I did not know it!"), the 3rd and 4th graders went on a God Hunt to find God, like Jacob. In addition to studying about 1000 years of Jewish history in ONE DAY, the 7th graders began planning their Mitzvah Day. We will be collecting a few items to support their project. Be on the lookout for more details soon!
