Dear Religious School Families:

There was SO much happening on Sunday, from music to mitzvot to masks, from buddies to books to tablets!

I hope our Pre K-1st grade learners are enjoying the masks they made with their buddies. They can think about building their Purim costumes around these masks for when we return to celebrate Purim on March 23rd for Munchkin Minyan and Sunday the 24th for our Religious School Purim Palooza!

2nd graders have lots to say about the life of Moses. Be sure to ask them about the 10 commandments and Moses as a leader.

3rd and 4th graders had another choose-your-own-adventure Jewish immigration experience and heard another of our Temple Shalom family immigration stories. Ask them about what they are learning about our stories of coming to America.

Our 5th & 6th graders worked on an interview that will be sent home so they can interview someone in your family about YOUR story. Please take some time to ask your children about who they would like to conduct this interview with and what they hope to learn.

I'll be sending more information home to all our 3rd-6th grade learners about these interviews and more. When they return from Spring Break on Sunday, March 24th for Purim Palooza we will begin cooking every week and creating our family cookbook. Don't forget to think about what recipe you want to share/include.

7th graders reflected on their definitions of tzedek/justice and chesed/righteousness from last week and continued to engage in acts of tzedek and chesed including working with their buddies, packing snacks for Family Gateway and identifying a Righteous Among the Nations person to research. Please ask your 7th graders about who they are planning to research and if there are any specific mitzvot/acts of justice and righteousness they hope to engage in during the remainder of the year. I am eager to hear their suggestions.
